Public Comment

Monthly Report

Erwin Lanier, Project Director, reported that we will be establishing a Chester Parking Authority Facebook page, which will allow the citizens and motorist to chime in with any particulars that they would like to bring to our attention. We will also be able to use that page to set forth any special edicts or notices accordingly. This will give us a relationship that we haven't had, thus far, in which we can have daily conversations with citizens and motorists.

The second conversation is about handicap parking. We have been enforcing that over the past few months, particularly those who have not placed placards in their windshield, which is by state regulations. Putting it on the dashboard is not sufficient. Handing them in the front is. If you are driving you do not have to have the placard in the windshield. Obviously, if you have a handicap plate, the placard is not necessary.

Thirdly, considering handicap with metered parking unlike other jurisdictional areas you do not get an hour free additionally. However, timed parking, you do get an additional hour. That timed parking, will particularly be in regards to: two (2) hour parking, fifteen (15) minute parking and half-hour (30) minute parking, you get the additional hour. Again, statewide it is jurisdictional and I just wanted to have clarification for that.
